# What to expect during the year??

#### Training

Different speakers will contribute to training. Training will focus on real-life experiences that will be intentionally facilitated. This process aims to help you realise the magnitude of who God is and what He is doing. It will help you discover more of who you are and what your purpose is and will encourage you to recognise and unleash your potential.

### Journey

Be prepared to participate in every form of ministry. You will serve, clean toilets, build houses, paint, sand walls, wash babies, feed the poor, care for the sick, pray over cities, walk in faith, spend time in the Word, share the gospel, worship God, witness while travelling, sing, dance, do puppet shows, preach... live... love... and the list goes on!

#### Questions that may arise during your process that are valuable to engage in:

- What is my heart towards the poor?
- What is servant leadership?
- What is integrity?
- What does it mean to live a God-seeking lifestyle?
- What are the principles I want to live by
- How do I address and feel about tolerance and truth?

- Emotions?
- How do I relate to sinners?
- How do I hear the voice of the Lord?
- Who am I?
- What is obedience, and how do I walk in it?



## Debrief

There will be a facilitated time of formal debriefing at the end of the year, where teams will give feedback and process what they have experienced in the year in preparation for the continuation of their life journey.



## Who Should Consider Going on the Journey?

#### A desire to serve

The only model of leadership we believe in is servant leadership. Participants will be challenged to live unselfishly and simply. **Philippians 2** is one of our guiding scriptures in defining servant leadership, it would be beneficial to begin journeying through this scripture.

#### A spiritual, intellectual and emotional growth challenge.

"The mark of a leader is a lifelong learner" therefore it is important to see the whole journey process as a training ground. The curriculum is unique in that it is not limited to the four walls of a classroom, it comprises both "learning" and "doing" and will require participants to go into the journey with: ...a desire to be challenged, to seek and to learn.

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
